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

una piccolissima rivoluzione

(in progress)

It was December 2022 when some pupils from Prato told me that at school they feel neither seen nor heard, that they often live with the feeling that time is never enough, that they are afraid of failing and that everything they do never seems enough for them or for the world. These problems are the same ones that weigh on the lives of so many adults.

It seems very difficult to find solutions, but I believe this project is a great opportunity to reflect on them together, to transform, even if only slightly, the time and space in which we live.

In April, May and June, I communicated with the students of Prato through letters, audio, video, phone calls and postcards, with the desire to experience limits as possibilities, to change some habits, even if only slightly, and, above all, to make the students protagonists of the whole experience.

In the last meeting, I proposed that they transform the classroom, even if only with small interventions, to make it a personal and, at the same time, collective space.

During the month of June, I then worked with some thirty teenagers to build a growing manual, a very ambitious guide to accompany the reader in making his or her own very small revolution.

On 23 June 2023, we experienced the practices together with the visitors and the Centro d'Arte Contemporanea Pecci in Prato became an explosion of joy.

ripensami tra 20 anni ripensami

(2018-ongoing)

This project won't end soon.

We will have to wait 20 years for it to be fulfilled.

It is an itinerant experience involving young people and the communities in which they live. It starts with the fear of the violence of the present and seeks to disobey it in order to cultivate future possibilities.

It consists of questions about 2020 and 2040, of autobiographical books that hold the answers, of a guided tour in the dark, led entirely by the youths and, finally, of a contract, a commitment to meet again in exactly 20 years' time, in the same place, at the same time, to see what will have happened in regards to our predictions.

The first stage was in 2018 at Smart, Polo per l'arte Contemporanea in Rome, the second in Prato, at Officine Giovani, and the third and fourth in Figline Valdarno (AR) and Incisa (Fi) together with Fondazione Palazzo Strozzi, Impresa Sociale Con i Bambini and Oxfam Italia; the fifth in Arezzo tghere with Liceo Artistico Francesco Petrarca; the sixth in Limbiate (MB), together with Recovery for Life.

condominy

(2018-2020)

Condominy, as the name suggests, is a condominium. It is an imagined building, and at the same time a real one, designed and built for and with its inhabitants: the young participants of the Youth Project at the Istituto Nazionale dei Tumori in Milan.

During periods in which therapy forces them into isolation, the time available may seem too much and the space too little. Many of the youths come and go from Milan for their therapies, others have lost track of the world as they knew it because of their illness and are looking for new points of reference.

Condominy is for all of them.

Its rooms are entirely imagined by the young people: microcosms that gather their desires and needs. These rooms have been given a shape and many colours thanks to the casatibuonsante architects, who have tried to find design solutions in line with the young clients' requests. From the presentation of the project, to the choice of name and rooms, all communication flowed online on the "condominy terrace" (secret fb page).

la terra è bassa

(2019)

In Donori, which is in Sardinia about 30 km from Cagliari, there is the Bar Tazza d'oro Snack. It is the only gathering place. It is open all day (from 6am to 2am).

In the mornings it is mainly women who go there, in the afternoons and evenings mainly men of various ages.

People sit and talk.

Next to the Bar Tazza d'oro Snack is the town hall. On its roof stands the bando, an electric amplifier used to broadcast rather formal public announcements.

"Hello, how are you?

...

I'm in Donori, Sardinia. I'm here for Contemporary, a festival of avant-garde art.

I have to tell you something important: the whole town is listening to us now, our voices are being broadcast by the amplifier in the Town Hall.

If it bothers you, we can talk in a more intimate setting, otherwise, if you're ok with it, I'll explain why I'm calling.

. . .

I arrived in Donori on the night of the 16th and, over the next two days, instead of visiting the town, I spent nearly all my time in the bar. I was curious to hear about the town from the people who live there. I gathered a lot of information, opinions and stories. I am calling you because I would like you to know something about Donori, through the stories of some of its inhabitants. I'd like you to choose one of the themes that have emerged: the origin of the name Donori, how the inhabitants perceive the town, stories of departures and returns, work, the relationship between young and old, leisure time...'.

Caterina

(2017-2019)

Caterina is an experience developed for A più voci, the program that Palazzo Strozzi, since 2011, has dedicated to people with Alzheimer's and their caregivers.

Caterina was born from of a reflection on the possibilities that people living with Alzheimer's have of relating to the world.

Through four stations, a room in Palazzo Strozzi was transformed into a travel space, into a path of mutual acquaintance between two people, into a waiting room for the elderly person and their carer, before meeting Caterina: a young woman who has been shut up in her thoughts for a long time and can't wait to get out again.


What should someone who is about to set forth after a long period of separation from the world know?

Caterina trusted her, more or less, young visitors, who with generosity and empathy gave her precious advice.

In the end, she left, and from her travels, to thank them for their many suggestions, she wrote many letters, one to each couple who had visited her.

The advice and the letters are now preserved in a golden book.
